Teachers and schools can choose to set up a private cleanup event any day during **September 13-24th** at a beach or on your own campus. You can also provide community service or extra credit for students who show up on Saturday the 25th!

**In 2009, 5,200 volunteers in Monterey County and Santa Cruz County removed a total of nearly 21,000 pounds of trash and recyclables that would have otherwise entered the Bay!**
